Meetups – DCV Member-Managed

DCV encourages Members to invent, realize and manage their own Events.

What are they and how do they work?

- Events planned and communicated directly by members.
- Posted on DCV Listserv.
- Specifically, listed with **Meetup** in the heading of the email.
- Planned-in-advance, or spontaneous (same day/week).

What are they not?

- Not planned or organized by DCV itself.
- Not listed on the DCV Calendar.
- Not necessarily coordinated with DCV itself.

What are some ideas for Meetup Events?

- Movies
- Concerts
- Museums
- Restaurants
- Think-tank Talks
- Walking and Biking tours
- Spas, Gyms and other Healthcare Centers
- Zoom Celeb Salon group views at a member's home.
- Trivial Pursuit (or another game) played at a member's home.

What are the responsibilities of the Meetup Event Organizer?

- The Organizer takes the initiative and lead.
- Post it on the DCV Listserv:
 - Provide a brief description.
 - o Include date, time, location.
 - Provide RSVP instructions:
 - Respond ONLY to the Member Organizer
 - Centralize via the Organizer's email address.
 - Title Format: Meetup ______
- Manage the Event.
- After the Event, email the number of actual participants to the DCV Executive.

How will DCV support Meetups?

- DCV will keep a list of Member-announced Meetup Events.
- DCV may reach out to Meetup Organizers afterward, to ask for useful feedback.
